1. Reference (a) is a precept for survey of USS TAYLOR (DD-468).
2. Reference (b) is a report of a materiel inspection of USS TAYLOR (DD-468) completed by Sub-Board of Inspection and Survey, Pacific on 19 April 1969.
3. The Board finds USS TAYLOR (DD-468) unfit for further service due to her material condition and failure to meet the criteria of reference (a).
4. The following costs provided by reference (c) are noted:

a. Acquisition	-	\$ 7,733,735
b. Replacement	-	22,000,000
c. Modernization to meet criteria paragraph 1A(2) of reference (a)	-	13,500,000
d. Scrap value	-	84,000

The Board estimates repair costs in excess of \$800,000.

5. Based on the above considerations, it is recommended that:
  - a. USS TAYLOR (DD-468) be stricken from the Naval Vessel Register.
  - b. All useable equipment as designated by the cognizant technical command be removed from the ship prior to disposal.
  - c. She be disposed of in accordance with the laws and regulations prescribed for disposal of Naval ships.



FIRST ENDORSEMENT on PRESINSURV ltr ser 446 of 8 May 1969

From: Chief of Naval Operations  
To: Secretary of the Navy

Subj: Survey of USS TAYLOR (DD 468)

1. Forwarded.
2. The USS TAYLOR (DD 468), a Fletcher Class destroyer, completed construction in 28 August 1942. The ship has never been modernized, and her capabilities are not up to fleet standards. As a consequence she is not considered to meet present and future warfare requirements. To bring her capabilities up to date, and also to undertake required repairs, would be prohibitively costly.
3. The President, Board of Inspection and Survey has found the USS TAYLOR (DD 468) unfit for further naval service and has recommended that the ship be stricken from the Naval Vessel Register. The Chief of Naval Operations concurs and recommends that the USS TAYLOR (DD 468) be stricken on 2 July 1969 as provided for in Title 10, USC 7304.
4. Subsequent to the striking, authority is requested to dispose of the USS TAYLOR (DD 468) in accordance with existing law in a manner most advantageous to the government.
5. Pursuant to the requirements of Title 10, USC 7307 and because this ship has been found to be unfit as required by law, it is hereby certified that the USS TAYLOR (DD 468) is not essential to the defense of the United States.



1. CNO European Trip Action Item No. 63 states "The Italian Navy desires two Fletcher class destroyers and requests that the U.S. make an offer." An offer of two such ships was made on an "as is, where is" basis at a sale price of \$150,000 per ship.

2. References (a) and (b) provide authority to strike the USS TAYLOR (DD 468) and USS WALKER (DD 517) on 2 July. Reference (c) provides Government of Italy acceptance of the two ships. A joint decommissioning and transfer ceremony will be held 2 July 1969 at San Diego.

3. In view of Congressional interest in the loan of capital ships, it appears advisable to apprise the Congress of the sale of the two destroyers. The U.S. Navy can legally sell the ships as they have been declared unfit and will be stricken from the Naval Vessel Register without the need for Congressional authority. The Fact Sheet to be transmitted is in the form in which the appropriate Congressional Committees will be notified.

1. Enclosure (1) is forwarded for coordination within the Department of Defense in providing information to the Congress of the United States concerning the sale of USS TAYLOR (DD 468) and USS WALKER (DD 517) to Italy.

FACT SHEET ON:

Sale of Stricken Ships to Italy

BRIEF OF ISSUE:

U.S. Navy ships when no longer considered suitable for future operational requirements, are declared excess and stricken from the Naval Vessel Register. Two such ships, which would otherwise be disposed of for scrap, are being sold "as is, where is" to the Italian Navy.

NATURE OF THE ACTION:

Two active fleet destroyers, the USS TAYLOR (DD 468) and the USS WALKER (DD 517) will be stricken from the Naval Vessel Register on 2 July 1969 as they are unfit and not essential to the Defense of the United States. They will be sold thereafter to the Italian Navy as surplus equipment.

REASON FOR ACTION:

1. Not modernized since construction in 1942 and capabilities not up to fleet standards and unfit for future USN requirements.
2. Ship not suitable for Naval Reserve Training or mothballing.
3. Sale advantageous to U.S. Government and U.S. Navy.

ADVANTAGES TO U.S. GOVERNMENT AND U.S. NAVY:

1. The Destroyers will augment the ASW Forces of the Italian Navy and will be part of NATO assets in time of war.
2. Sale price of \$150,000 per ship plus purchase of follow-on support will result in positive gold flow.
